


Upper Teeth Erupt

Canine (cuspid)	11-12 years	
First premolar (first bicuspid)	10-11 years	
Second (second bicuspid)	10-12 years	
First molar	6-7 years	
Second molar	12-13 years	
Third molar (wisdom tooth)	17-21 years
